# Infirmary Mailbox

To enhance communication and ensure the safe handling of student health needs outside of infirmary hours, **we are introducing a secure, locked mailbox located at the Reception Area to the left of the Command Post.** This new system allows parents and staff to confidentially drop off medications, prescriptions, after-care summaries from medical appointments, and documentation from urgent or emergency visits when the infirmary is closed. The mailbox is positioned within view of a security camera for added safety and monitoring. Nearby, you will also find communication forms and plastic bags available for submitting prescription bottles and vitamins.

The mailbox will be checked each morning and as needed throughout the day. Upon receipt, a confirmation email will be sent from the Infirmary staff to acknowledge the items received.

We appreciate your cooperation as we work to improve our response and care systems for all students.



## Streamlining Student Prescriptions for Better Care

To help us provide timely and consistent care for your student, we are streamlining how prescriptions are managed and picked up by staff. We kindly ask families to consider sending all student medications to the **24-hour Walgreens** located at **1021 Summit Ave, Oconomowoc, WI 53066 (Summit & Thackeray)**. This location allows our staff the flexibility to pick up prescriptions at any time, ensuring medications are available when your student needs them most. We understand some families may already use other pharmacies. While that's okay, centralizing prescription pickups from one location greatly helps staff coordinate and avoid delays.

Families are encouraged to place a credit card on file with Walgreens (or their chosen pharmacy) to avoid additional charges from the school for medication pickups.
